June 18, 2021

Pursuant to notice by the Interim-Executive Director, the Regular Meeting of the Retirement Board of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority Retirement Fund was held on Friday, June 18, 2021, at 9:32 AM, at One Washington Mall, 4th Floor, Boston, MA 02108.

The Members present by video conference were James Bradley, Craig Hughes and Betsy Taylor; Alternate Members were, John Clancy, Patrick Hogan, Gerald Kelley, Timothy Long and Mary Ann O’Hara.

Also present were John P. Barry, Interim-Executive Director; Jacquelyn Carey, Acting Recording Secretary; and staff. Julian Regan and Pamela Dubuc of Segal Marco Advisors were also present.

Executive Director reported that Interim-Chairperson James Evers would not be in attendance.

On motion, duly made and seconded, it was unanimously

VOTED:- TO appoint Patrick Hogan as Temporary Chairperson.

Temporary Chairperson Patrick Hogan presided.

SECTION II – REGULAR SESSION

a. Minutes

The Chairperson stated that the next item on the Agenda was the Consideration of Minutes of Prior Meeting of the Board, May 21, 2021. He inquired if there were any questions. None were asked.

i. General Financial Reports

Mr. Barry directed the Board's attention to the Financial and Flash reports and gave an account of the Fund's financial activities for the month of May 2021. He reported that for the month of May, the Fund had a total of \$12,291,546 in deposits and \$18,816,060 in withdrawals for a net-negative of \$6,524,514. He added that the market value at the end of May 2021 was \$1,838,949,201. The Executive Director reviewed the overall performance of each of the Fund's asset classes in comparison to their respective benchmark.

On motion, duly made and seconded, it was unanimously

VOTED:- TO approve the General Financial Report of the Executive Director for the Month of May 2021.

On motion, duly made and seconded, it was unanimously

VOTED:- THAT the Retirement Board of the MBTA Retirement Fund move into Closed Session.

The meeting went into Closed Session at 9:37 AM.

The regular meeting reconvened at 10:30 AM.

SECTION IV – REGULAR SESSION

On motion, duly made and seconded, it was unanimously

VOTED:- TO retain the current 2019 contribution rates for the Authority and the Members in an effort to pay down the MBTA Retirement Fund's unfunded accrued liability.

The Chairperson stated that the next item on the Agenda was the Board consideration and vote regarding the 2020 Audit Report and 2020 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR).

On motion, duly made and seconded, it was unanimously

VOTED:- TO Approve the 2020 Audit Report.

VOTED:- TO Approve the 2020 Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR).
