i. General Financial Reports

Mr. Barry directed the Board's attention to the Financial and Flash Reports and gave an account of the Fund's financial activities for the month of July 2025. He reported that for the month of July, the Fund had a total of \$19,517,760 in deposits and \$20,404,510 in withdrawals for a net-outflow of \$886,750. He added that the market value at the end of July 2025 was \$1,885,179,875. Mr. Barry reviewed the overall performance of each of the Fund's asset classes in comparison to their respective benchmarks reporting that Global and International Equity are having a strong year. Mr. Barry highlighted that the total fund is outperforming the policy mix and matching the allocation mix for the month of June 2025.
