MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
July 17, 2026

Pursuant to notice by the Executive Director, the Regular Meeting of the Retirement Board of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority Retirement Fund was held at 9:31 AM on Thursday, July 17, 2026, at One Washington Mall, 4th Floor, Boston, MA 02108.

The Members present, in person or by video conference, were James Evers, James Bradley, Timothy Long, Mary Ann O'Hara, Chanda Smart and Paul Todisco. Additionally, Alternate Members present were James Joyce, Gerald Kelley, John Mersereau and Wayne Peacock. Also present were John P. Barry - Executive Director, Jacquelyn Carey - Recording Secretary and Fund staff. In addition, Julian Regan and Pamela Dubuc of Segal Marco Advisors were also in attendance.

Chairperson Evers presided.

SECTION II – REGULAR SESSION

a. Minutes

Chairperson Evers stated that the first item on the Agenda was the Consideration of Minutes of Prior Meeting of the Board, June 18, 2026. He inquired if there were any questions. None were asked.

d. Report of Executive Director

Chairperson Evers stated that the next item on the Agenda was a report from the Executive Director.

i. General Financial Reports

Mr. Barry directed the Board's attention to the Financial and Flash Reports and gave an account of the Fund's financial activities for the month of June 2026. He reported that for the month of June, the Fund had a total of \$20,368,501 in deposits and \$20,881,102 in withdrawals for a net-outflow of \$512,601. He added that the market value at the end of June 2026 was \$2,156,503,382. Mr. Barry reviewed the overall performance of each of the Fund's asset classes in comparison to their respective benchmarks, noting total fund is outperforming both allocation and policy mix for the month. Mr. Barry noted that the annual Newsletter was distributed last month and there was also an article from the Fund's IT manager, Robert Biga, published in the Boston Business Journal. Both documents were provided in the board package.

Chairperson Evers thanked Mr. Barry for his presentation.

On motion, duly made and seconded, it was unanimously:

VOTED: TO approve the General Financial Report of the Executive Director for the Month of June 2026.

Chairperson Evers asked for a motion for the meeting to move into Closed Session to cover retirement applications where personal information may be disclosed along with confidential investment information.

On motion, duly made and seconded, it was unanimously:

VOTED: THAT the Retirement Board of the MBTA Retirement Fund move into Closed Session.

The meeting went into Closed Session at 9:36 AM.

The regular meeting was reconvened at 10:59 AM.
